## The USC String Project is a nationally recognized model of community service and teacher education.

The USC String Project offers instruction in violin, viola, cello and bass to students. Each beginning class consists of approximately 20-25 students, with a minimum of three teachers in each class!

The students in the String Project are 3rd through 5th graders. The lessons will be twice a week and there are 4 choices:

Tuesday and Thursday at 4:00-5:00

Tuesday and Thursday at 4:30-5:30

Wednesday and Friday at 5:00-6:00

Tuesday and Friday at 5:30-6:30.

Classes are reasonably priced at \$80 for each of the two 12 week semesters. Parents will need to provide or rent instruments from a music store.

We also have an adult class that meets Wednesdays from 5:30-6:30! (\$100).

The organizational meeting will be on September 3 at 6:30 p.m. If there is space available after the main registration night, we will also take registrations on September 4 and September 5.
